

sledding penguins


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STEP 4: Small Penguins Center small egg piece on white fleece oval. Pull fleece around egg to flat side and glue in place. For eyes on one penguin, mark two small 1/4" slanted lines. Thread needle with two strands of black floss. Bring needle from back of head to front, making a 1/4" slanted stitch. Return thread to back of head; repeat for second eye.

For second baby penguin, insert eyes as for large penguin. Apply blush to cheeks with brush. Glue beak pieces together and glue to faces under eyes of both penguins in same way as large penguin. Glue one wing angled up to each side of baby penguins.

STEP 5: Small hats. Turn up long edge of yellow polka-dot fabric 1/2", twice. Glue folded edge down. Overlap raw edges and glue together. Gather end and tie together with an 8" piece of blue floss. Repeat for green polka dot hat, tying end with orange floss. Glue hats on heads.

STEP 6: Finish. For one small penguin with eyes open, fold wings up almost covering eyes and glue in place. Glue one baby penguin to each side of large penguin. Wrap large wings around them and glue in

place. Apply blotches of snow on sled. Glue penguin to sled. Glue two snowballs to front of sled. Glue two snowballs under back of sled rungs so it tilts forward.
